Calton Road, Edinburgh

IQA completed the installation of lighting, emergency lighting and small power within the 33kV substation at Calton Road in the centre of Edinburgh.

The works involved the installation of steel cable tray containment and steel wire armour cabling, distributing all power from the distribution board within the Kingpar control room to lighting and power outlets throughout the main substation unit, cable ducts and adjacent transformer rooms.



All of our installations are designed and installed to comply with 17th Edition IEE Wiring Regulations BS7671:2008. This project also met with the requirements of Ingress protection for weatherproofing -IP65 - and included weatherproof switches, socket outlets and light fittings.

All work was completed to client specification and in compliance with Scottish Power Safe Systems of Work. IQA completed all works ahead of the client's completion deadline.
